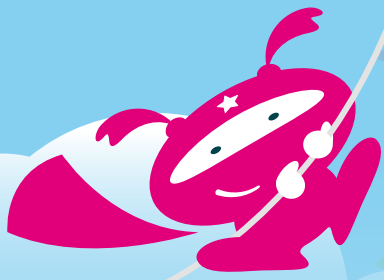


Superhero film night



Step 1

Choose a classic superhero film that you think people would like to come and see.

Step 2

Find a venue to screen your film – it could be someone's house, your work meeting room, or you might even be able to persuade your local cinema or theatre to show the film for one night.

Step 3

Step 4

Step 5

Fundraise!

- Sell sweets, bags of popcorn and drinks.
- Hold a quiz at the end of the film, charging £2 per quiz sheet, to see how closely they watched the film!
